Parish Level Pilgrimage during the Jubilee Year of Mercy:

Would you like to join Fr. John Peter Swaminathan on a **parish level pilgrimage to the following designated churches on the 30th of April, Saturday beginning at 9 a.m. and return by latest 2 p.m.?** Yes, we are making plans to undertake this small pilgrimage on a parish level to the below mentioned four Churches. We will all travel in our school bus and stop at the following churches starting from The Cathedral of Our Lady of Perpetual Help, OKC, and ending at St. Gregory’s Abbey Church, Shawnee after which we will have our Lunch in Shawnee and return back to Okarche. You can leave your cars in the parking lot of the church and can ride the Bus. There is no cost involved. During our Journey we will say a Rosary and one Divine Mercy Chaplet. The bus holds 30 people comfortable and so all those who would like to ride the bus please call the parish office and reserve your seat. There is no need of driving but just relax and pray. This is an excellent opportunity for us to do something concretely in the Jubilee Year of Mercy.

How to gain an Indulgence this Holy Year of Mercy:

The Jubilee Indulgence can be gained each time a person crosses through the Holy Doors in one of these Churches, under the usual conditions. Celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation within several days (about 20) before or after; receive the Holy Eucharist; pray for the intentions of the Holy Father. Only one indulgence can be gained on any given day.

The Following are the Churches that we will stop and enter through the Holy Door:

The Cathedral of Our Lady of Perpetual Help, OKC; St. Joseph Old Cathedral, OKC; St. Wenceslaus Church, Prague; St. Gregory’s Abbey, Shawnee

What is an indulgence? “An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury of the satisfactions of Christ and the Saints.” “An indulgence is partial or plenary according as it removes either part or all of the temporal punishment due to sin.” The faithful can gain indulgences for themselves or apply them to the dead.

Pilgrimage to Guatemala—A pilgrimage to Guatemala has been planned for this summer to mark the 35th anniversary of the martyrdom of the Servant of God, Fr. Stanley Rother, which occurred on July 28, 1981. Archbishop Coakley will lead the five-day trip, Monday-Friday, July 25-29 Fr. Stephen Bird is coordinating the pilgrimage.
