Status on the Renovation Project—Once again I am happy to update you all with regard to the current status of the renovation work on the old convent building that we have undertaken six weeks ago. Before I do that I would like to let you know the financial contributions we have received so far. We have in cash \$586,310.35 (which includes \$100,000 each from Holy Cow Fund and Parents Association) and \$85,470 in pledges. As of now 105 families have participated in the financial offering to the project and I am most grateful to these families for having contributed to the building project. There has not been much of an increase in the donations although the bountiful harvest is over. Please consider in giving back to God in the measure He has blessed you with. Out of 360 registered families only 105 have given to this building project. Please be generous to this project as we are in full swing of work and would like to move on with the new administrative building planning.

We are still committed in getting the project completed as promised. We are trying as much as possible to complete the inside work before school begins. We are still committed in having the refurbished class rooms finished by the first week of August for school there was some delay in the work due to some unforeseen circumstances. The State inspector was here and it delayed a bit. The electrical work took 3 weeks in complete instead of 2 weeks. The plumbing is over and that gave us some complications and it is now fixed. Pioneer telephone work is completed. Right now sheet rocking of the ceiling is underway. By next week we should be able to paint inside and finish the inside works and move on to start the outside work.

At this time I am most grateful to my building committee and more particularly to Gerald Knecht, Kay Rother, Gig Stroh and David Krittenbrink who punch the clock two times every day and who are committed in what they have taken on themselves. They give so much of their time for the good of our parish and we should be proud of them. I am positive that you are very much impressed with the renovation work as much as we are. We are happy with the way we are moving forward and the work we have begun is moving well. We would be more grateful if you want to be part of the building project by your contributions. Thank you.

Books must be paperback, as no hardcover books are allowed in the jail. No books about criminal activity, jailbreaks, etc. are allowed for obvious reasons. If you intend to help the prisoners with the above materials or would like to make a donation for this cause, you are most welcome and we would forward everything to the prison ministry through concerned person. Jim & Marie Murphy Living Trust

Jim & Marie Murphy, faithful members of Holy Trinity Church now deceased, wanted Holy Trinity Church to be a beneficiary of their Estate at their demise. They willed that Holy Trinity should get 12% of their estate. Accordingly the Jim Murphy & Marie Murphy Revocable Living Trust has sent \$10,908.96 to the Catholic Foundation of the Archdiocese of OKC which is now added to the Holy Trinity Church Endowment Fund. The rest of the amount will be sent to the Catholic Foundation towards the end of the year which would probably be around \$14,000. We will let you know once we are in receipt of the remaining amount. They did not want a separate memorial to be set but wanted it to be part of the endowment fund. I am grateful to this family and more particularly to their children although not members of Holy Trinity but their desire to respect the last will of their parents is very much appreciated. God is blessing our parish so much by way of these people who have gone before us and wishing that our parish grow even though they are not with us. All these extraordinary people inspire us in some way or another to give back to God in the measure that He has blessed us here on earth. May they inspire us as we move along with our building project.
