1. If Your Child Is Absent From School

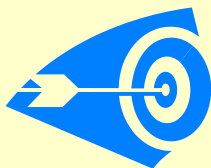
we request that you call the school office by 10:00 a.m. each day of the absence to let the staff know that he or she will not be in school.
